General Details

Note that all memberships are due for renewal on 1 April each year. Applications are not usually accepted in the last two months of a membership year – please apply instead for the next year. Members are governed by the rules of the society. Please contact our secretary for details of our Constitution, insurance coverage and privacy policy. We are not registered for GST and do not issue Tax Invoices. For renewing members only an extra \$1.00 fee applies to offset postage costs for receipt. Branch membership is an OPTIONAL addition to Region membership and is only available to members of Native Plants Queensland. New memberships receive a “Welcome” pack with information and brochures and this pack will also include a copy of our most recent journal. Membership cards are no longer being supplied.

Our new “Members only” section of our website is available to all members who have provided a valid Primary email address. Note that this email is unique and the same email address can not be used for different persons included on one membership.

Our quarterly full colour *Native Plants Queensland* Journal is published in June, September, December and March and is posted to all memberships. We also publish a monochrome “Annual” each year which includes reports from our Region councillors and our branches. Multi-person memberships will receive only one “set” of our publications, not a set for each member. Note that memberships joining in the last half of our membership year (after 1 October) at the 50% discount rate will only be entitled to receive the last two journals published during the membership year (the December and March issues).

1. **Secure online payment with credit/debit card via our website** – for new applicants and renewals. Only available if you have provided (or are providing) a valid primary email address. Follow instructions on our website. **Renewing members will receive renewal instructions by email.**

3. **Mail to Membership Officer.** Post to PO Box 5702 BRENDALE QLD 4500. Make cheques / Money Orders payable to “Native Plants Queensland”. (Credit card payment option **ONLY** available for applications from outside Australia. Do **NOT** send cash in the mail)
4. **At one of our events.** Payment can be made by cash, cheque or money order or, at some events, by EFTPOS with credit or debit card.
5. **Payment via a branch MAY be available.** Branch members and intending branch members should contact the local branch treasurer for details of payment options. Many branches accept Region fees and may prefer applicants and members to pay Region fees via the branch.
