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General Details

Note that all memberships are due for renewal on 1 April each year. Applications are not usually accepted in the last two months of a membership year – please apply instead for the next year. Members are governed by the rules of the society. Please refer to our website and/or contact our secretary for details of our Constitution, insurance coverage and privacy and data protection policy. We are not registered for GST and do not issue Tax Invoices. Membership of one or more Branches and/or the national ANPSA Study Groups are OPTIONAL additions to Region membership. Student Membership is available to full time students and proof of Student Status is required (e.g. copy of Student card). New memberships receive a "Welcome" pack with information and brochures and will also include a copy of our most recent journal.

Our "Members only" section of our website is available to all members who have provided a valid (and unique) email address. The same email address can not be used for different persons included on one membership.

Our quarterly full colour Native Plants Queensland Journal is published in June, September, December and March and posted to all memberships. We also publish an electronic (PDF file format) "Annual" each year with reports from our Region councillors and our branches. Multi-person memberships receive only one "set" of our publications, not a set for each member. Memberships joining in the last half of our membership year (after 1 October) who choose the 50% discount option are entitled to the last two journals published during the membership year (the December and March issues).
